General Conditions

1. The Prize is awarded annually in two categories: a person and a nongovernmental organization.
2. The Prize is awarded for actions enhancing the peaceful coexistence and cooperation of communities, religions and cultures.
3. The Prize is awarded after an examination of applications by the Award Committee, functioning according to the Regulations.
4. Candidates for the Prize may be from Poland and abroad.
5. Candidates for the Prize may be proposed by individuals and nongovernmental organizations from Poland and abroad.
6. It is not possible to award at the same time a nongovernmental organization and a person related to that organization in the same year.
7. Candidate's consent upon nomination is required (no written approval is required)
8. The Prize winners receive Andrzej Renes' statuette and a commemorative diploma. The Prize may also be financial.
9. The Award Committee might award an honorary Special Prize. Candidates to the Special Prize might be proposed by the members of the Committee.

Application Process

1. An applicant may propose more than one Candidate for the Prize, each time submitting a separate Nomination Form.
2. An applicant chooses the right category for their Candidate, fills in and submits the Nomination Form. The Nomination Form has to be filled in legibly, with detailed information describing the nominated person/institution and his/her/its actions.
3. An Applicant may attach to the Nomination Form additional documentation.
4. Nomination Forms have to be sent by 30 June each year to: Villa Decius Association, 28 Lipca 1943 Street, 17A, 30-233 Krakow
5. Electronic Nomination Forms will be taken under consideration only if the conditions of credibility and accuracy are met.
6. Nomination Forms without complete data or filled in illegibly will not be taken under consideration.
7. Nomination Forms not meeting the above conditions will not be taken under consideration by the Award Committee.

Information about the Contest and the Announcement of Results

1. Schedule of the Contest
 - April 1 - announcement of the subsequent edition of the Prize
 - June 30 - closing date for the submission of Nomination Forms
 - July 31 - Nomination Forms are sent to the Award Committee
 - First half of September - official session of the Award Committee
 - Fourth quarter of the year - announcement of the results

4. The Award Committee might address the Applicant and third parties linked to the Candidate's activities for additional information and materials.
5. Nomination Forms not meeting the requirements of the Regulations will be rejected.
6. The Submission of Nomination Forms signifies an acceptance of the conditions stipulated in the Regulations.
